The new school is slowly inching closer. We are still expecting a term 4 start but the exciting news is the contractor is predicting (everything going to plan) that we will be moving into the new school buildings in September / October 2019. Once we have moved in the old school buildings will be removed and the areas converted into the new playing fields.

The Ministry of Education redevelopment funding is allocated to cover:

- New buildings
- Removal of the old buildings
- Development of playing fields and basic landscaping

There is separate funding from the Ministry to cover new school furniture, which in our case will cover only a portion of what will be required. Over the last 5 or so years the Board of Trustees has been preparing for the arrival of the new school. The board has been budgeting to ensure that we have the necessary funds available, to purchase the necessary basics to allow us to move into and work in the new learning environments.



A big thank you to the members of the Friends of Te Huruhi Society who have been busy raising funds to ensure that we have outstanding playgrounds for our tamariki in the new school. We are hopeful that we will have raised enough funds to enable us to:

- Move and reinstate the Rope playground (which is currently by the outside stage area).
- To purchase two new playgrounds to replace the old playgrounds which can't be reused.

Our plan is to have these playgrounds purchased and installed, ready to use, from the time we move into the new school. This is to provide a play area for the tamariki whilst the playing fields are created. Based on the current timeframes we could be without



playing fields for an entire term - so playgrounds will be necessary to enable our children to have engaging activities in a small space. (Please note the playground designs are just examples)

The Friends of Te Huruhi Society is open to all members of our whanau (community) and they are always on the lookout for fundraising ideas. Please contact the school office for further information and contact details.

### School Communication

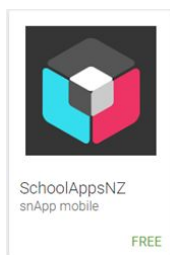
School App- the purpose of the APP is to try and improve school communication and provide parents with a one stop shop for all school communication including
